Eastern Iowa Airport (Code CID)

The Eastern Iowa Airport in Cedar Rapids is just 49 minutes (43 miles) from West Liberty and provides more than 80 arrivals and departures per day with non-stop service to 12 U.S. cities: Atlanta, Chicago O'Hare, Cincinnati, Dallas/Ft. Worth, Denver, Detroit, Las Vegas, Minneapolis/St. Paul, Orlando, Phoenix/Mesa, St. Louis, and Tampa/St. Petersburg.

Quad City International Airport (Code MLI)

Quad City International Airport is 58 minutes (54 miles) from West Liberty and serves travelers with over 60 daily arrivals and departures on major airlines including:

Iowa City Airport (Code IOW)

lowa City Municipal Airport is 26 minutes (17.5 miles) from West Liberty and is a general aviation airport located in the southeast part of lowa City. Of the 113 public airports in lowa, it is the second busiest general aviation airport in the state.


- Runway Lengths: 5,004 ft. (1,525 m) x 100 ft. (30 m) wide, and 3,900 ft. (1,189 m); both 150 ft. (46 m) wide
- Fixed Base Operator (FBO) Jet-Air provides line services; fuel: 100LL and Jet A; mechanics; instruction; and charter and aircraft rental.

Muscatine Municipal Airport (Code MUT)

The Muscatine Municipal Airport is 36 minutes (22 miles) from West Liberty and is a general aviation facility for use by the community. Many of the large local industries in the area have private hangar facilities at this airport.

- Runway Lengths: 5,500 ft. (1,676 m) x 100 ft. (30 m) wide, and 4,000 ft. (1,219 m) x 75 ft. (23 m) wide
