

Bi-State Drug & Alcohol Consortium Testing

Responses to questions by proposer DSI Medical Services, submitted June 6, 2023

1. Who is your current TPA/provider(s) managing your drug/alcohol testing program now & SAMHSA LAB conducting the urine testing?
 - The Consortium's current TPA is TSS. The current SAMHSA Lab being used is Clinical Reference Laboratory, located at 8405 Quivira Rd, Lenexa, KS 66215.
2. What walk-in clinics do you currently use, and where are they located? Is this number of clinics, and their locations, acceptable to the Consortium member's needs, or do you wish for more options? Will there be an occasional need for an external collection at a local walk-in clinic outside the Counties you have already listed?
 - The Consortium currently has 16 testing sites. They are meeting current Consortium needs. There should not be a need for walk-ins beyond the five (5) counties that are listed. The names and locations of the sites are listed below.

4. Where could we obtain current pricing for this contract?

Currently, each individual test is priced as following

 - DOT Urine Drug Test - \$87.50
 - BAT - \$50.00
 - BACT- \$45.00
 - After-Hours Collection \$135/hr with a 1 hour minimum plus the cost of any tests conducted
5. Why is this bid being solicited? Has all renewal option expired, or has there been an interruption with the service?
 - This bid is being solicited because the current renewal option has expired.
6. Would there be any interest in utilizing the ELECTRONIC chain of custody form, or is the Consortium currently using this technology to cut down on errors that happen on paper CCFs?
 - There may be the possibility of using an electronic chain of custody form, but we would need to confer with our Consortium members to see if that is feasible for all of them. If the proposer would like to utilize an electronic chain of custody, more information would need to be included in the proposal: who needs access to the system, how is this access controlled, are secure emails required to interact with the system, etc.
7. Is there any interest in receiving pricing on additional services related to DOT testing: FMCSA Clearinghouse Query submission, DOT Physicals, Supervisor training on Reasonable Suspicion?
 - Pricing for additional services may be provided as an appendix. These supplemental prices must be wholly separate from the drug and alcohol test prices.
